CORF OFFER

Core offer – Non-examined subjects

Our curriculum offer at Corby Technical School includes a number of subjects that are taught as part of our the DfE statutory framework. This aspect of our personal development curriculum is very important to all students and is delivered as part of our curriculum lesson time as well as in assemblies and tutor time. This aspect of our curriculum covers the following subjects and areas:

- Religious Education (RE)
- Personal, social, health and social education (PSHE)
- Relationships, health and sex education (RSHE)
- Careers, Education, Information, advice and guidance (CEIAG)
- Core PE

Core offer – Examined subjects

You will study a number of examined subjects that are known as 'core' subjects, this will be the same in any other secondary school. These subjects are as follows:

- English Literature (1 x GCSE)
- English Language (1 x GCSE)
- Maths (1 x GCSE)

Science is also a core subject, and you will have two different pathways that you can choose for science.

- Science pathway 1: Combined Science. This course covers all three sciences (Physics, Biology and Chemistry) and is a qualification worth 2 x GCSEs.
- Science pathway 2: Separate Sciences. This means that you will still study all three sciences, but each science subject is worth 1 x GCSE, you will therefore have 3 x GCSEs (1 x Physics, 1 x Biology, 1 x Chemistry) if you choose to study separate science. This will use one of your option blocks.

Summary of the core offer

The examined subjects that you will study as part of our core offer are as follows:
